The BRC is run by a committee of 18 elected parents of boys who play Rugby for Barker. Election is annually at the AGM.

The BRC is focused on all levels of Rugby within the college. There is a particular focus on those who represent the future of Rugby at Barker, the Junior and Middle schools.

Joining the BRC, by the payment of a once only contribution, you directly contribute to the future success of the club. You will assist the club to provide funding for the ongoing activities, which supplement and support the considerable investment made in Rugby by the school.

### **The BRC meets its objectives by;**

- \* Providing specialist training equipment for Rugby Training. For example the BRC has recently committed to the funding of two scrum machines.
